Parent Meeting Survey Thank you to everyone who responded to the recent survey following the Target Setting telephone meetings. We had 155 responses and of the responses received 87% stated they preferred virtual meetings. I am so pleased that the feedback from parents has been so positive, with many commenting how the' virtual meetings fit better into my busy life as a working parent' and that the meetings were 'more private and convenient'. Other positive comments were `I felt the teacher could focus on my child, it didn't feel rushed with other parents waiting`. Parents also felt the booking system was easy to use. Of the 13% (20 responses) who preferred face to face meetings the main reason cited was 'I wish to look at the whole book not just the examples of work sent home`.

Therefore based on the feedback received we will continue to hold virtual parent meetings for Spring term but look to consider ways to send books home before the meetings whilst ensuring they are back in school for the children to continue using.

We will continue to review parental feedback following the meetings next term.
