

Maths

Children will be focusing on measurements and converting between different units of measure such as time and money.

They will also be learning about angles in shapes and also continue to strengthen their number skills when solving worded problems.

The children will also be taking a mental math test every fortnight to help develop their mental strategies and arithmetic.

Computing

The children will be looking at Microsoft Office term and understanding how to use Word, Excel, PowerPoint and Publisher.

They will also be learning about the dangers of the internet and what to do to lower the risk of these dangers.

English

The children will be looking at wide range of grammar skills and punctuation needed to enhance their writing. They will be writing in a range of genres to demonstrate the skills they will learn. They will be learning to use dialogue between characters to develop setting and plot. They will also have to write, edit and perform by heart a piece of poetry about London's history. Children will also be tested on the 100 words they need to learn to spell by the end of year 6.

ART/DT

In Art, the children will be researching and recreating World War One propaganda art.

In D&T the children will be designing a working model of a river, explaining all the different stages.

SCIENCE

Space

In this unit, the children will be learning about the universe that we live in. This will include investigating how planets move in relation to the sun, explaining the moons orbit of the earth and also how earth experiences night and day.

States of Matter

Children will be investigating the different states of matter and compare materials. The children will learn how to use the correct terminology when writing up experiments.

GEOGRAPHY

The children will be learning about rivers across the globe and studying the effect on wildlife and surrounding humans.

HISTORY

The children will be learning about World War One. They will be finding out how this conflict began, what new weapons were used and the effects it had on the men who went to fight, but also the people who were left at home.
