COMPUTING

Children will be learning basic computer skills such as logging in, using a keyboard and mouse control using different programs and devices as well as computer safety and coding

MATHS

Children will be investigating number, shape, space and measures and handling data through a variety of activities.
Children will be exploring number order and patterns, 2D and 3D shapes, comparing height, feet and hand length, and creating pictograms, bar and tally charts, among other activities.

ART/DT

Children will be using a variety of media to create art, including portraits.
Children will learn about the importance of healthy diets and be making a fruit salad

MUSIC

Children will explore sounds and duration as well as learning songs for the Christmas Play

SCIENCE

We will be looking at the body and exploring our senses. Children will be looking, smelling, tasting, feeling and listening in a range of activities.

They will also be looking at seasonal changes of Autumn to Winter and how animals, including humans, share similarities and differences.
