Free School Meals

Are you entitled to claim free school meals for your child?

To be entitled to a free school meal for your child you must be in receipt of one of the following:

- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension • Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided they are not • entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income of £16,190 or less, as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs

If you receive any of the benefits listed please speak to Mrs Collins in the school office to apply for your child's free school meal.
