

Maths

In Maths, the children will be strengthening their knowledge of multiplication, division and fractions. They will also be learning how to measure, estimate and draw angles. Alongside this, the children will develop an understanding of mass, volume and capacity through various mathematical investigations.

ART/DT

In Art, the children will be learning all about Georgia O'Keefe Artist study. We will have the opportunity to use watercolours and understand wax resist painting.

In DT, the children will be looking at different chocolate recipes whilst linking this in with nutrition.

RE

During RE the children will learn about the different faith and values including life stances and understanding where they belong in a community.

GEOGRAPHY

The children will be learning about the similarities and differences between the UK and Mediterranean countries. They will learn how the location features, culture and climates differ in various countries and compare this with the UK, and explore the scenery of these different countries.

Computing

This term in computing we will continue to develop word processing skills through the use of Microsoft Word and Powerpoint, as well as producing graphs and spreadsheets.

English

The children will continue to learn and use features identified in reading, including adventure stories, Biographies, Reports and letter writing. Children will also continue to apply their SPAG skills to all pieces of writing whilst learning to proof read and edit effectively.

SCIENCE

Plants

Children will understand the functions of a flowering plant and explore the best conditions for a plant to grow. We will also be looking at a flower life cycle and investigating ways in which water is transported.

Animals including Humans

The children will learn about why humans need the right type of nutrition and be able to identify why humans have skeletons and the different uses of muscles.

MUSIC

Music lessons will follow a scheme of work called Charanga. The children will focus on using their voices as musical instruments and develop an understanding of musical composition.

PE
