

## MATHS

Children will recap place value, partitioning, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division. As well as build on previous knowledge of fractions, percentages, decimals, 12/24 hour clock, problem solving 2D and 3D shapes.

## ART/DT

Portrait drawing techniques  
Focus – facial expression & body language in sketches and paintings.

Textiles Victorian bag/ purse.  
Children will learn basic stitches to sew together pieces of materials as well as following through the design, make and evaluation process.

## RE Sikhism

We will be focusing on the festivals and places of worship within Sikhism.

### Faith and values

We will be looking at big questions such as what is truth, and discussing about those who do not have a faith.

## GEOGRAPHY

### Water cycle and weather

We will be learning about the water cycle, different types of weather and what causes the weather to change.

## MUSIC

We will begin to control our voice, including pitch and tone, with various singing exercises. Furthermore, we will begin to read and play sheet music, with musical instruments

## COMPUTING

Children will continue to practice computing skills such as mouse control and typing. Children will also be applying these skills whilst learning computer literacy, different software and their uses.

## ENGLISH

Learning and using features identified in reading, including adventure stories, biographies, reports and letter writing. This term we will also be reading, writing and performing a range of poetry and fiction texts.

## SCIENCE

Living things and their habitats  
Children will study living things and the environments they live in. They will be able to classify animals and understand how environments and habitats can change and the dangers of this.

### Scientists and inventors

Children will learn about famous scientists and inventors and be able to discuss their impact on the wider world.

## HISTORY-

### The Victorians

We will be looking at the changing face of Britain and focusing specifically the Victorian period. Within this, children will learn about the significance of the industrial revolution and how the roles of children have changed since then.

## PE

We will be continuing to use the Real PE scheme to learn new skills and improve existing ones. We will then build up to applying these skills to game situations.
