

Maths

We will continue to revise all areas of maths, focusing on areas for development identified within each class; number, operations for calculations, fractions, geometry, statistics, measure, problem solving.

English

Stories from European cultures, imaginative recounts, descriptive techniques, poetry. Information texts, report writing, instructions, alongside weekly comprehension, handwriting, spelling, punctuation and grammar tasks.

Computing

We will continue to practice 'E' Safety - keeping safe when using the internet, as well as the using the internet for research. We will use online coding programs to develop greater understanding of computer systems.

ART/DT

In Art, we will be observing and commenting on the pointillism technique of painting by famous artists such as Seurat, Van Gough and Luce.
In DT, we will explore seasonality of foods and design healthy, seasonal menus.

SCIENCE

21st Century Science- we will investigate modern science and how it is being used in our lives. We will focus on the development of vaccines, linking with history topic and current global issues, as well as space exploration and stem cell use. The Human Circulatory System- identify and name the main parts of the body involved in the circulatory system, and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood.

RE

We will look at how different religions encourage community cohesion within their own faith community and the wider society.
